


DAY GUADELOUPE

High above, Fort Napoleon and Le Chameau peak are flanked by fragrant forests of fern and frangipani, overlooking picture-perfect landscapes bathed in golden sunlight and sailboats afloat on gin-clear bays.


DAY MARTINIQUE

Hike beside waterfalls, ponder the flying buttresses at Cathédrale St-Louis, and savour cocoa farms, local rum, and artisan sorbet in the shade of one of the island's enchanting gardens.

8 Sugar-Coated Basseterre

Formed by volcanoes, St Kitts fertile soil is so rich it turns monkeys green. Experience a train ride, sailing trip, cooking class, sky safari zip-line, or creative batik fabric workshops. Visit sugarcane plantations, the Narrows between St Kitts and Nevis and the UNESCO Brimstone Hill Fortress for spectacular views of neighbouring islands. 
DAY PUERTO-RICO



History and Horticulture at Fort Napoléon

First built in the 1700s, Fort Napoléon des Saintes was never actually 'in battle', so to speak. Instead, it was primarily used as a prison. Today, it's neither prison nor military site; instead, it's a museum dedicated to the history of the Îles des Saintes, or Les Saintes, archipelago. Make the drive from the waterfront up to the fort, savouring views of the other islands and the sun-kissed Caribbean. Then, step inside and explore the museum. When you've had your fill of history, peruse the Fort's exotic garden (famed for its iguana habitat and specialist succulents). Afterwards, enjoy a delicious buffet lunch of traditional local foods.

Trek across a world of verdant, tropical foliage until you reach the soft sands and calm waters of Katouche Bay. The experience concludes with a local, culturally beloved refreshment before you head back to port.
