SCENIC ROUTE

PANORAMIC TOUR - NAS01



Duration
2:30 h



Drive through Nassau to reach the highest point of the island, from where you will enjoy a beautiful view of the harbor. At this location, you will have time to explore the Queen Victoria Staircase, do some light shopping on your own, and take pictures. Then, you will head to Paradise Island, followed by a photo opportunity at the Atlantis Resort. Continue with a drive past the Government House and the Parliament Building before you stop at John Watling's Distillery, where you will be welcomed with a pina colada rum sample, learn about the process of rum making in Nassau, and enjoy some time on the outdoor patio. We will then pass by Fish Fry and Junkanoo Beach for a photo stop, from where you will see your ship in the harbor, before returning to the pier.

Please note: Guests must be at least 21 years old to consume alcohol. The driver of this tour is also the guide. This tour is considered not suitable for guests in wheelchairs. Guests with walking difficulty and mobility problems should consider that there is a walking distance of approximately 1 mile/1.6 km to cover from the ship to the buses. The order of stops visited may vary.

SEAHORSE SAILING ADVENTURES - NAS05

This tour offers the ideal combination of the best Sailing and Snorkeling in Nassau. After a short stroll from your cruise ship, you will board a catamaran featuring a shaded lounge and bar area with a deck for sunbathing. You will then cruise through the historic Nassau Harbor while enjoying the beautiful sites & surroundings. You will arrive at a lush natural reef teeming with tropical fish and sea-life for swimming and snorkeling. During your cruise, you will receive your snorkel gear and instructions by the crew who will also accompany you into the water to ensure your safety and enjoyment. A snack and a full bar will be available to you after snorkeling (for one hour) along with complimentary filtered water and fruit punch throughout.

Please note: Guests must be at least 18 years of age to consume alcohol and must be able to provide a valid proof of ID. NASSAU BY JEEP WITH LUNCH - NAS06

**Duration**
3:30 h

Drive a Jeep through downtown Nassau and its suburbs, taking in attractions such as the caves where the indigenous Lucayans once lived and then pausing to relax approximately 30 minutes at the beach. After a short walk from the pier, you will hop into a Jeep Wrangler and hit the open road. There is plenty to see during your time behind the wheel, starting with downtown Nassau, the capital, largest city, and cultural hub of the Bahamas. Likewise, you will have an opportunity to see areas rarely seen by tourists while visiting Nassau. You will then head west towards the Nassau Caves for a photo stop. Enjoy scenic views of the JFK Memorial and the Tropical Gardens. Free time on one of Nassau's beaches follows, during which you might stroll along the shore, bask in the sun or simply admire the natural beauty and serenity of the sea. Then after a bountiful lunch, you will return to the pier.

Please note: Tour is priced per person, not per vehicle, you may be paired with other guests, maximum 4 guests per vehicle. If you wish to have your own jeep, you will be required to pay for its full capacity of 4 guests. Please inquire with the shore excursions desk onboard should this be the case so that the remaining spaces can be charged to your onboard stateroom account. The minimum age to drive is 25 years with a valid driver's license. There are 3 stops on the tour where you will be able to switch drivers. Maximum weight limit is 300 lbs. per person. Maximum Height is 6 feet 2 inches. Guests must be at least 5 years of age to take part. Chairs and umbrellas are not available at the beach.

Discover the legendary Atlantis with a full day of adventure. Aquaventure is the largest water park in the Caribbean, boasting 141-acres of water rides and pools. This non-stop aquatic thrill park features incredible Atlantean-themed towers, thrilling high-speed water slides, a mile-long river ride with rolling rapids and wave surges, a kids' water-play fort, and access to the resort's unique and refreshing pools and beaches. More than a water park, Aquaventure Day Pass includes access to Atlantis' iconic marine life habitats and some of the most beautiful beaches in The Bahamas. Explore the largest open-air marine habitat in the world with over 250 species of sea life making their home in natural ocean-fed environments. Embark on a self-guided tour of the underwater ruins of ancient Atlantis in The Dig and explore a labyrinth of underground passageways brimming with exotic marine life.

Please note: There is a considerable amount of walking on this tour and guests must be at least 48 inches tall to ride the water slides. Poseidon's Play Zone water play fort and slides are accessible for children under 48 inches tall. Lounge chairs, towels and life jackets are provided. Non-motorized water sports are available for rent. Lockers available at extra cost. No cash, only credit card at outdoor facilities. Return to the ship is on a shuttle basis. Shuttle bus timetable will be communicated before arriving at Atlantis. This tour includes full access to the water park, aquariums, pools & beaches. This tour lasts a minimum of 4 hours. BLUE LAGOON ISLAND BEACH & SEA LION ENCOUNTER - NAS24

Take a short transfer across the water to reach Blue Lagoon Island and spend a few hours enjoying a sea lion encounter and relaxing on the beach. Make your way to the purpose-built, waist-deep platforms in the lagoon to begin your sea lion encounter. In groups of 10 or fewer guests, you'll get to interact with some of the world's most endearing marine mammals. Play, hug, feed and rub down your new pals, while professional on-site photographers capture all the action on film, both stills and video footage. These lasting memories will be available for purchase at the end of your wildlife experience. During your time on the island, you'll also be able to catch views of Atlantic bottlenose dolphins, native nurse sharks and southern stingrays in their natural lagoon environment. Afterwards, you can go for a swim in the calm waters or simply stretch out in a lounge chair or hammock under coconut palms and unwind.

Please note: Guests will be required to wash their hands before and after the animal interaction. Guests must be at least 8 years of age and/or 1.22 (4 ft.) in height to take part. Children between 8 and 12 years of age must be accompanied by a paying participating adult while they are in the water. Upon completion of the programme, you will have free access to the lagoon beach. All food and beverages and/or water sports are at an additional cost. The last visit on your walk will then be the mid-18th-century Chapel of Christ the Saviour before your return to the ship.
