

3 Eternally Exciting Messina



5 Cagliari: Sardinia’s Historic Capital

Cagliari fans out from the steep slopes of Il Castello, the hilltop citadel built by Pisan rulers in the 13th century, home to the opulent Cathedral of Santa Maria and bloody Elephant Tower, where trophy heads once hung. The seven-kilometre expanse of Poetto Beach unfurls from the Devil’s Saddle (Sella del Diavolo) on St. Elia promontory, past a string of beachfront eateries where legendary Sardinian seafood is enhanced by crisp chilled Vermentino. Across the waves, the irresistible waters of Capo Carbonara Marine Reserve teem with colourful coral fans and kaleidoscopic sea creatures.

6 Submerged Secrets in Alghero

Watch the sun melt into the horizon from Alghero's monumental towers, three sentinels that keep watch over ancient walls. Don't miss pretty Bosa, maiden of Sardinia, or the churches and museums of Sassari. Local wines are the perfect pour with lobster alla Catalana, plucked fresh from the deep blue sea.

History will take shape before your eyes at the ancient site of Torralba d'en Salort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site whose mighty monoliths bore witness to ancient rites. Strolling the undulating earth, you'll encounter a *taula*—meaning 'table' in Catalan—a striking T made of two colossal rock slabs, thought to have been a place of worship. Wander through the relics and talayots (stone towers), listening as this place's history is explained. Returning to the present in Mahón, known as Maó in Catalan, whitewashed homes and historical buildings tell the stories of the city's cosmopolitan past.
